#### Grant Guidelines - Eligibility Requirements

IMPACT IMPACT IMPACT INSPIRE Nonprofit Focus Areas Education Health Ed, Health, Social Social Any 501(c)3 organization satisfying the grant guidelines and with a program within the scope of our funding guidelines may apply for funding to support social outreach and charitable service programs that benefit the community at large. Impact Central Illinois does Requirement not require the organization to refrain from incorporating its foundational ideology of justice and charity in its program methodology, activities, or facilities which serve the community at large. However, as a collective giving organization, Impact Central Illinois reserves the right to determine the grant recipients based upon full disclosure of that ideology. We will review any projects/programs which serve the community at large BUT organizations must fully disclose any restrictions the organization may have Disclosures related to Restrictions on Participation, Required Statements of Belief, Required Affiliation, and Required Public Display of Support **Capital Improvement** Property owned by organization or leased min 5 yrs as of 1/1/2024 Debt reduction, Endowments/memorials, Bridge funding or interim financing, Operational deficits, Partisan, political lobbying or legislative activities, Private Foundations, Litigation/legal expenses, Fundraising expenses, & General advertising expenses\* Not Allowed \*unless advertising is directly related to the organization's proposal to directly offer services to the community


Phase 1 - Financial Documentation & Organizational Questionnaire is now open and accepting submissions until January 1, 2025 @ 11:59 EST

  - 2023, 2022, & 2021
  - Past 3 990s (990,990-EZ), or ICI Financial Review Template completed & signed with 3 years of year-end financial data
  - Check guidelines for detailed requirements
- 501(c)3 designation letter (copy)
- CO-1 registration form from IL Attorney General (copy)
- Most recent audit, if organization is audit eligible
- Organization questionnaire (completed online)





- All organizations reviewed and considered ready to receive and implement a grant from ICI will receive an invitation to submit a grant proposal and budget to the 2025 grant cycle

- 91 different organizations have applied for our grants
- 15 different organizations (17%) have won
- 5 of the 15 (33%) were first time submissions
- The other 10 (67%) submitted at least two and up to four different times.
- But, unfortunately 30% of organizations only submit one year if they do not become a grant recipient.
- Encourage you to remain part of the process


